- Improved understanding of partner approaches and intervention strategies
- Additional tool for strengthening collaboration and coordination among all partners
- Highlight some key issues concerning teacher policies that merit additional work and consideration

# II. PERTINENCE OF THE STUDY

Numbers, quality and equity: the three challenges for winning the battle for EFA

- The increase in **numbers** of school-age children requires significant increase in the **numbers** of teachers.
- Enhancing equity implies coherent deployment of teachers based on local needs.
- Quality of education is highly dependent on the capacity of the teacher to enhance learning outcomes.

## III. METHODOLOGY

The results of the study draw on a pilot data base created especially for the purpose

- Enabling continuous updating of information
- Providing dynamic and comparative overview of partners' policies and programmes

### IV. THE MAIN TRENDS


The key role of a fairly small group of donors.
 Interventions aimed principally at pre- and in-service training and systems management.
 Relatively low coherence of development partner policies.
 Little or no impact evaluation, in particular on longer-term learning outcomes.

☐ Weak link between investigation and research, and action

### V. <u>RECOMMENDATIONS</u>

- Federate the efforts of key donors to achieve complementarity and convergence of policies and action.
  Give pride of place to political dialogue.
  Ensure political will to adopt and implement reform strategies focused on learning outcomes.
  Revisit and redefine the concept of quality as related to teacher policies (and therefore make better use of research)
- Emphasize a holistic approach.
